# Come to Fukushima Prefecture for enjoying "Autumn color and history!!"

■Shingu Kumano Shrine Nagatoko(Kitakata-city)  
Nगतoko is "Haiden (hall of worship)", which was built a thousand years ago. The ginkgo tree is 800 years old with a trunk 8 meters around. It is worth the visit to see the tree lit up and the grounds turned autumn gold with fallen leaves.

Season: Mid-late Nov (40 min drive from Banetsu Expressway Aizuwakamatsu IC)



■Nanko Park (Shirakawa-city)  
Japan's oldest park constructed in 1801 by Sadanobu Matsudaira, a Roju (senior councilor of the Tokugawa shogunate) who conducted the famous reformation of shogunate administration. The autumn leaves reflecting on the lake is amazing.

Season: Late Oct – mid Nov (15 min drive from Tohoku Expressway Shirakawa IC)

■Ginkgo Street in Azuma Sports Park (Fukushima-city)  
The 520 meters long street lined with 116 ginkgo trees is a popular spot for autumn color. The street is lit up at night to create a magical atmosphere.

Season: Late Oct – mid Nov (10 min drive from Tohoku Expressway Fukushima-Nishi IC)
